- B. Approval of Claims Payable from September 1, 2020 through September 15, 2020 for the General Fund and for the Water Department.

1. Proclaiming September 17 – 23, 2020 as Constitution Week. Town Clerk Chapin read the Proclamation.

#### • **DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

1. Second Reading and Public Hearing, discussion and possible action concerning Ordinance No. O 20-04 captioned as follows: RELATING TO BUSINESS REGULATIONS; TO CONFORM TO ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES TITLE 9, CHAPTER 13 AS ADOPTED BY LAWS 2018 CHAPTER 331 (SENATE BILL 1140); AND ADOPTING THE MODEL UNIFORM VIDEO SERVICE LICENSE AGREEMENT AND THE APPLICATION AND AFFIDAVIT FOR UNIFORM VIDEO SERVICE LICENSE.

Mayor Coon asked if there were any updates from staff or any council discussion. Town Manager Grier stated this is the second reading of the ordinance and staff is available for any questions. Council Member Rappaport asked if the term is to be ten years. It could be up to ten years, responded Town Clerk Chapin. Council Member Rappaport asked if this would interfere with the 5G with APS. Mr. Grier responded he doesn't know what APS will provide. Licensing agreements can be concurrent with each other. This is a fee that is paid to the Town, so it doesn't give them exclusive right, concluded Mr. Grier.

Council Member Rappaport questioned why it is retroactive to July 1<sup>st</sup> and asked if that was because of bookkeeping. That is correct, responded Ms. Chapin. Ms. Chapin explained the League of Cities counsel recommended the Town adopt the forms formally with a resolution and an ordinance. It is retro-active because council adopted the forms last June and July 1<sup>st</sup> is the date when all the cities and towns were required to comply, concluded Ms. Chapin. There were no further questions or discussion. Mayor Coon opened the meeting to the public. There was no public present and the mayor closed the public hearing portion.

A motion to approve and adopt Ordinance No. O 20-04 adopting the Model Uniform Video Service License Agreement as written was made by Council Member Davis and was seconded by Council Member Armington.

A roll call vote was taken:
