CALL TO ORDER

- **DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ITEMS:**

1. **First Reading and Public Hearing concerning Ordinance No. O 20-05 captioned as follows: AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAR VALLEY, ARIZONA, TO REPEAL AND REPLACE ORDINANCE NO. O 20-03.**

Town Manager Grier explained the Town is trying to go back to the Board of Supervisors of Gila County to have them consider the annexation of a certain portion of the public right-of-way of Highway 260 on the east end of town. Mr. Grier asked if anyone has any questions. Council Member Rappaport asked if the right-of-way deannexation is from Lion Springs to Preacher Canyon. “Correct,” answered Mr. Grier. There were no further questions. Mayor Coon stated he assumes everyone is satisfied with the ordinance. Since this is the first reading, added Mayor Coon, there will be no council action. Mayor Coon opened the meeting to the public. There was no public in attendance and the mayor closed the public hearing portion.

During this portion of the meeting, members of the public may address the Town Council on items that are not on the printed agenda.
