## • **DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

1. An update on the Payson Senior Center provided by Janice Chesser, Director of Development.

Mayor Davis introduced Janice Chesser, Director of Development for the Payson Senior Center. Ms. Chesser explained that she stepped into the position in December and gave an update on the building project for the new senior center. She stated the project is located near Malibu Street by the roundabout and the Payson Police Station and is still a mess. Bids for construction have come in at \$2 million more than projected and therefore they are looking at downsizing the plans. They discussed some options with the Town of Payson which didn't prove viable. However, reported Ms. Chesser, the Senior Center is breaking the ice with a fund raiser at Star Valley Community Park called "Freezing for a Reason Ice Dip" on April 6<sup>th</sup> using dunk tanks. She said there were going to be several Star Valley Council Members participating in the event. She also stated that there were going to be two Craft Fairs put on by the Senior Center to raise money. The Senior Center is growing, reported Ms. Chesser. They fed up to 87 people for the St. Patrick's Day lunch and they distribute 155 meals per day for Meals on Wheels. They do encourage people to eventually attend lunches at the Senior Center for socialization. She said they are also rebranding the Senior Express Bus to Rim Country Rides which will include people with disabilities. Mayor Davis asked if there were any questions and there were none. He thanked Ms. Chesser for all she does.
